

Family Volunteer Requirements, 2023-2024

Jasper Freeride operates as a not-for-profit Ski and Snowboard team and relies heavily on parent and family volunteers to assist in the club's operations. Many hands make light work and we encourage everyone to get involved and help out with our on-hill and off-hill projects. The more work we can complete as volunteers, the better the training venues are for our athletes!

Early season:

Mogul course and Airbag construction and fencing. This usually occurs in late December and requires many volunteers to assist with loading supplies, setting up fences, building jumps, layout and construct moguls, chopping jump landings, etc.

Winter Regular Tasks:

- Saturdays & Sundays Airbag Shovel off snow and setup 9am
- Sundays Airbag Roll up This is usually done at 3pm
- Saturdays & Sunday Chop mogul jump landings 9am & 3pm
- Saturdays & Sunday Course fence maintenance sideslip snow, standup fences, etc
- Photography If you are good with a camera we need high quality images for marketing

Additional Tasks:

- Board of directors help with operation and strategic planning for our club.
- Fundraising 50/50s, silent auctions, corporate sponsorships and donations
- Competitions / Banquets on-snow and off-snow positional available
